Early Childhood Summer *Toddlers - Age 6*

Breakwater's Early Childhood summer session is an opportunity for young children to experience Breakwater's arts-based, child-guided learning approach, complimented by a host of outdoor activities and adventures! Inspired by the Reggio-Emilia approach to early childhood education, Breakwater teachers encourage each child's creative spirit and expression.

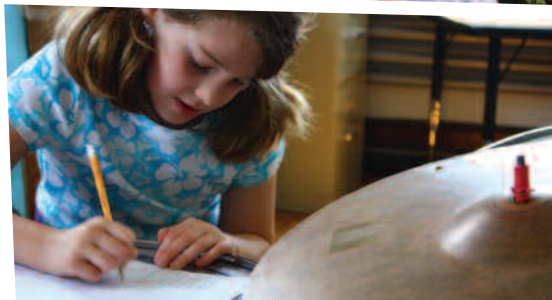
Breakwater Creative Arts *Ages 7 - 14* 9:00 AM – 4:00 PM

BCA offers exposure to a variety of performing and visual arts, as well as a creative approach to science, engineering, writing, athletics and outdoor adventure. The program is offered in two three-week sessions. Campers will be given the opportunity to choose their own classes from a wide variety of disciplines, taught by experts in those fields, and may make different selections for each session should they attend both. The three-week commitment will lead to an evening of culminating performances, a gallery opening and the sharing of final projects. The program will include special event days, guest artists and experts, mini-workshops in specialized areas, field trips, a noon time show when students share works in progress, and a free choice period.

Classes and activities include: musical, teen troupe, showtunes, hip hop dance, newspaper, creative writing, film, creative drama, ceramics, sculpture, painting, drawing, sports, lego robotics, low ropes course and more.

Summer Institute *Ages 7 - 11*

New this summer, Breakwater is offering an intensive academic program in reading and writing, as well as coaching in executive functioning for students between the ages of seven and eleven. The Summer Institute will have two three-week sessions that will meet Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday mornings with the opportunity for students to join Breakwater Creative Arts in the afternoon and for the full day on Mondays and Fridays. All three disciplines will be offered in a small-group format (2-4 students), and student groupings will be based on academic and/or age-appropriate needs determined by the program administrators.
